Admission Criteria

Candidates must meet the following admissions requirements:

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution
- At least 10 years of working experience holding a senior position, or who will be assuming a leadership position
- TOEFL/IELTS is required if undergraduate study was not conducted in English

Shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend an interview.

Application Process

To ensure that participants qualify and are prepared for the rigour of the programme, all candidates will have to go through a pre-qualification application, which includes the submission of essays, key supporting documents and your basic application information.

Successful applicants will then be invited to register officially to be matriculated as students of the programme.

We recommend you allow for ample lead time to prepare for the application and to gather the necessary documents.

STEP 1 Gather Your Supporting Documents

The following documents in PDF are required.

Whether you are self-sponsored or sponsored by your company, please get them ready before you register your pre-qualification registration online.

- **Letter/Email of endorsement from your Institution's HR/CEO (for Company-sponsored applicants only)**
- **Your updated resume detailing your past work experience and education credentials**

The letter or email should ideally articulate the support of your participation in the programme, including allowing you time off to be fully committed to the programme.

STEP 2 Write your Essays

Write your answers to the following questions limiting your answers to **no more than 2 A4 pages, 11pt sized font**.

1. What do you think are the current healthcare challenges in your country, and what do you think can be done to solve them?
2. What are the challenges you currently face at work, and how do you think you can solve them? (Please limit to no more than 3)

For the following two questions, please limit your answers to **no more than one A4 page, 11 pt sized font**.

3. What are your most important accomplishments to date?
4. Why have you decided to enroll in this programme, and how do you think it would help you in your leadership journey?

Please indicate your full name, title and name of institution at the end of each answer. Save your answers in 2 separate PDF files, ready to be uploaded.
