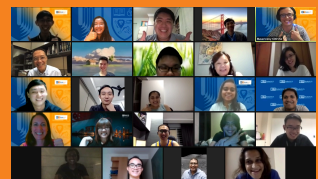

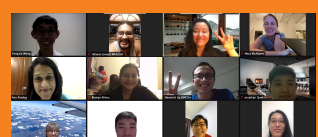

Conversation With Professor Ooi Eng Eong (Oct 2020)

On 19th October, we invited alumni and students for a conversation with Prof Ooi Eng Eong, the co-director of the Viral Research And Experimental Medicine Centre at SingHealth Duke-NUS (ViREMICS). Prof Ooi kicked start the session by introducing us to his research experience in dengue and other Aedes-borne flaviviruses, and the development and evaluation of novel therapeutics and vaccines. Of course, all of us were especially interested in learning more about his work involving COVID-19 and a vaccine for it, and it was especially valuable and inspiring to have the principle investigator who is developing a self-replicating mRNA COVID-19 vaccine (in partnership with Arcturus Therapeutics) to share with us his journey and insights.

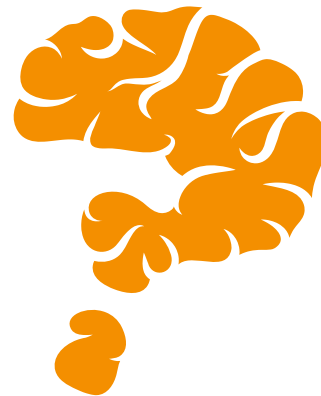
