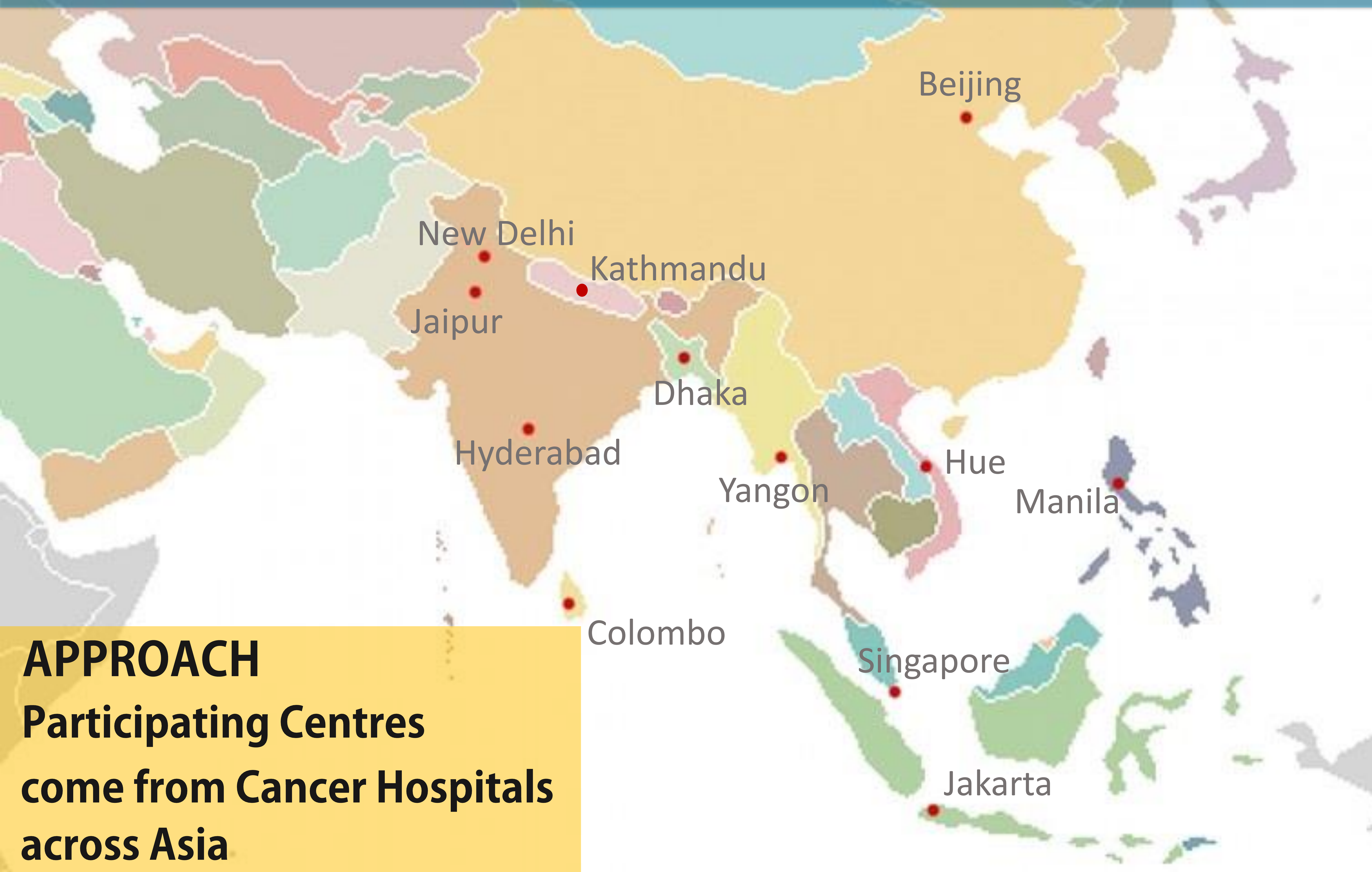

Objective

- To identify areas for improving end-of-life care among cancer patients

Methods

- One-time survey of 200 stage IV cancer patients in each participating hospital

Survey Domains

- Quality of life
- Quality of care
- Treatment decision-making
- Understanding of illness and prognosis
- Use of hospice palliative care
- Self-blame and social stigma
- Use of mental health services
- Use of complementary and alternative therapy

What we offer

- LCPC will provide limited funding, training, and research support
