A/Prof John Lim was invited to a panel discussion to share his insights and experience on the topic of 'New Horizons In Therapeutics and Interventions'.




A/Prof John Lim discussing the potential of "smart regulation" to overcoming issues in enhancing biomedical innovation and promoting access to good, safe and effective health products.

Describing the evolving healthcare landscape in Asia, A/Prof Lim touched on Asia's healthcare spending, which is likely to grow by 6.6% on average from 2015 to 2019 amid increasing marketing authorisation applications for medicines and medical devices, and a rising share of global clinical trials.

With the emergence of new data sources and advances in biomedical science and technology, A/Prof Lim discussed the potential of "smart regulation" to address oncoming issues in enhancing biomedical innovation and promoting access to good, safe and effective health products.

The panel discussion was chaired by Dr. Andrew Serafini from Kilpatrick Townsend and distinguished panelists included Prof. Paul MacAry from National University of Singapore, Dr. Wang Aiguo from Stryker Corporation and Dr. Bertil Lindmark from ASLAN Pharmaceuticals.
